## ORDINANCE NO. 2021 – 18 TOWN OF NASHVILLE INDIANA

## AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING A PORTION OF PITTMAN HOUSE LANE AS ONE-WAY

WHEREAS, the Town Administration of the Town of Nashville has brought to the attention of the Nashville Town Council that motor vehicle traffic during the busy tourist season has created a pedestrian safety concern on Pittman House Lane between Van Buren Street and Old School Way, and

**WHEREAS**, the Nashville Town Council believes that limiting motor vehicle traffic on Pittman House Lane between Van Buren Street and Old School Way to eastbound only may alleviate the problem.

## It is therefore **ORDAINED** as follows:

- 1. Pittman House Lane between Van Buren Street and Old School Way is hereby designated One Way Eastbound.
- 2. No person shall operate a motor vehicle in a westbound direction in said designated portion of Pittman House Lane.
- 3. Town Administration shall post appropriate signage.
- 4. The Town of Nashville Code of Ordinances, Chapter 72, Schedule I, "One Way Streets" shall be amended to reflect this designation.
- 5. Violation of this ordinance shall be subject to the penalties set out in the Nashville Traffic Code. (Section 71.99 of the Town of Nashville Code of Ordinances).
- 6. "This Ordinance shall be effective upon passage, publication and posting of signage.
