ORDINANCE NO. 2021 – 20 TOWN OF NASHVILLE INDIANA

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING HORSE- DRAWN CARRIAGE STANDS

WHEREAS, the Horse-Drawn Carriage Ordinance (Chapter 115 of the Town of Nashville, Indiana Code of Ordinances) requires the Town Council to designate locations for the licensees under said ordinance to pick up and discharge passengers, hereinafter referred to as "Carriage Stands," and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the safe operation of Horse-Drawn Carriages that the parking of motor vehicles in said locations be prohibited in said locations and

WHEREAS, The Town Council has, at public meeting, approved and designated the location of Carriage Stand.

It is therefore **ORDAINED** as follows:

- 1. The north side of West Franklin Street, between Van Buren Street and Honeysuckle Lane, commencing 25 feet from the intersection of Franklin Street and Van Buren Street is hereby designated and approved as a Carriage Stand, and shall be used solely for the loading and unloading of passengers from horse-drawn conveyances licensed by the Town. The balance of the north side of West Franklin Street between Van Buren Street and Honeysuckle Lane shall be reserved as a truck loading zone.
- 2. The south side of East Franklin Street, between Van Buren Street and Old School Way, commencing 25 feet from the intersection of Franklin Street and Van Buren Street is hereby designated and approved as a Carriage Stand, and shall be used solely for the loading and unloading of passengers from horse-drawn conveyances licensed by the town
- 3. The parking of motor vehicles in said locations is hereby prohibited.
- 4. Chapter 73, Schedule IV, "Parking Schedules," of the Town of Nashville, Indiana Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to reflect these designations.
- 5. All provisions of Chapter 73, Schedule IV in conflict with this amendment are hereby **REPEALED.**
- 6. Violations shall be subject to the penalties set out in section 71.99 of said Code.
- 7. This ordinance shall become effective upon passage, publication and posting of appropriate signage.
